We first came into contact with Morningstar School in January 2009. Morningstar School is situated near the shores of Lake Victoria in Mutungo approximately 15 km south from Kampala, the capital city of Uganda. Mutungo is a rural village where people live below the Ugandan poverty level equating to earnings of about \$1 a day. Our hearts were touched by the ministry of this school led by Sam Kisebo. In addition, the hunger of the children to learn and the dedication of the teachers have burdened us with the question:

“What can we do to help Morningstar School?”

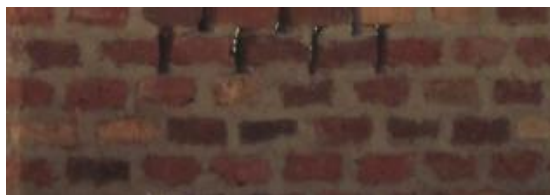


There are currently 6 classrooms for the 200 students. The classrooms are 12'x12' with dirt floors. They are comparative at this time to shanty shacks.



June 2010 trip

In June, Roth, Cylle, and Katie Rowell, and Doug DeVries will be returning to Uganda. Brick by Brick's mission is to help oversee the building of classrooms for the 200 children attending Morningstar School. We have met with an American contractor that lives in Uganda and trains Ugandans in construction. After visiting the school site and looking at the proposed plans, the contractor has told us that five classrooms can be built in three weeks time for about \$20,000. The classrooms will have concrete floors, a real roof, and will meet the government's standards for classroom size.
