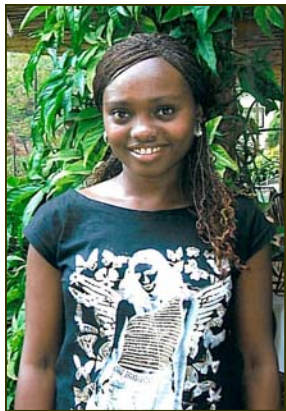

Joselyn Kirungi

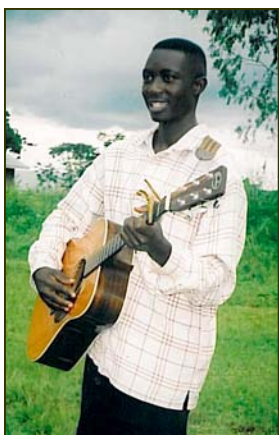

Her father deserted the family years ago, her mother remarried but the step-father refused to support Flavia since she was from a previous father, a common cultural practice in Uganda. After graduation Pastor Sam advised her to save money to get additional training. She took the advice and continued to advance in training. She saw an advertisement about jobs in London in Homes for the Aged. She applied and passed the interview. Only two were taken out of 87 applicants. Before she left for London she visited Pastor Sam with these remarks: “I am so thankful for if it was not for the project I would have never been what I am now. I would be rotting in the village.” She told Pastor Sam that upon her return she will be married to David a son of Pastor Sam’s late sister. David lived with Pastor Sam in Busoro and was helped with his training. He sings with Pastor Sam’s daughter Night Grace. Flavia’s contract in London is for one year and in her words she said she was going to be an Ambassador of the Good Samaritan Project in London. God is so good; He’s so good to us! Also, please pray for Medruth Neema and Joselyn Kemigisa who will graduate in February 2010 from Rosa Mystica in catering and food preparation management.

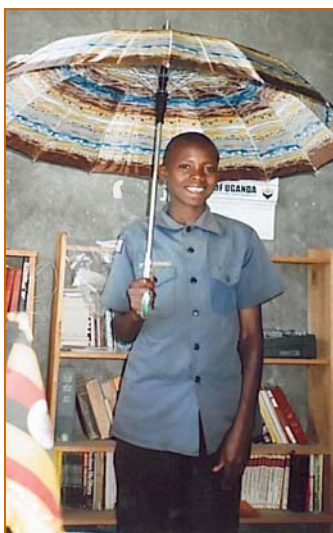
