In fact special support has come in to help with examination fees for some of the children, additional help for desks, tables and chairs for the Hope Christian school and more children added to the project. The project through God's grace now has 72 children supported. Pastor Sam's response to this outreach, "We are so grateful for the money for the Hope school. We are all full of joy. We have been able to purchase 20 desks and each can sit five children. Yesterday – March 3 – I collected the first ten and the other ten will be collected on March 11. How great is Thy Faithfulness Oh Lord! We pray God will provide more. We also lack office chairs (4) and tables for teachers. We trust and wait on God for these. Thanks again for your love and help in this area." Thank you sweet Jesus.

Through all, God is truly faithful. We believe all 20 boxes of supplies from the Vacation Bible school have arrived. What a blessing to know God protected all of them for all these months and all those miles. There truly is no boundary or limit to God's love and protection. Pastor Sam's response to this outreach, "We are overwhelmed by God's providence and protection. Eight more overseas parcels have been received in the past weeks all safely. Praise God! It has been great joy as I shared the various items with the children of the Good Samaritan. Pass on our appreciation to all who contributed these items." Thank you sweet Jesus.

"We had our February Bible study/fellowship on February 27 with the Good Samaritan children. It was yet another wonderful time with the children. We read from Psalm 1:1-6. The assignment to them was to memorize the same Psalm. How I pray that they will all grow to be that blessed man, delighting in the law of the Lord, meditating day and night on His word and grow like the tree on the riverside, bearing fruits...It is also my prayer that I will also be that blessed man.
