Dear Rev. Hamilton, Hayes, Pickett, and Anderson:

Isaac's Promise (IP) has become a supporting ministry partner of the joint venture ministry of the Africa Christian Training Institute (ACTI); The Office of the Church of Uganda (COU) - The Most Rev. Henry Luke Orombi, Archbishop; and The Presbyterian Church of Uganda (PCU) in Uganda.

The Goal

The goal of this venture is to assist the Ugandan Church in its plan to train and mobilize 100,000 Ugandans in evangelism/discipleship over the next 5 years to evangelize all of Uganda door to door including Muslim areas. We will be going to Uganda in August/September 2008 to meet and work with the Uganda Ministers of Ethics and Finance and other government and church officials as a "think tank" for twelve days to develop and begin implementation of this plan/strategy to accomplish this goal.

The Teams

When we return we will begin a tour of PCA churches to seek their participation with the Uganda Church in this Uganda plan. IP is partnering with Dr. Krabbendam on this mission, offering the DOMA Group's IOS process to each team member so that each person understands their unique gifts and to create effective teams to go to Uganda. Dr. Krabbendam is looking for churches/teams to go with him to Uganda in December 4 to December 23 (or for a portion of this time).

We have a special desire/focus for youth pastors (with some of their youth leaders along with parent, mission, and senior leaders) to go to Uganda in December but are recruiting pastors, church leaders, seminary students, retired couples, youth, and others (the Church!) to go as a team and return as a spark of revival in discipleship and evangelism in your local church, especially leading the youth to spearhead the discipleship and evangelism movement in your church's community. (Note: youth receive the extra benefit through the IOS process of receiving unparalleled guidance for choosing a college major, life calling, future career, etc.)

How IP Enters the Picture: Painting a Picture of the Church Working Together

Isaac's Promise is collaborating with a for-profit company called the DOMA Group which has developed and implemented a process over the last 20+ years of assessing an individual's unique motivations and gifts. IP has begun a ministry to deliver the DOMA Group's cutting-edge technology to seminary students and pastors so that: (1) seminary students know what they bring to the table when they connect with a church and (2) experienced pastors and church leaders are freed up to disciple seminary students/new pastors. For your information, we have attached some information regarding the DOMA Group and its president, Ralph Mattson.

We would like to offer this same IOS assessment to you and your church team that is going with Dr. Krabbendam to Uganda – and IP is willing to carry the cost for the initial groups that respond. Ideally, you and each member of your team going to Uganda could begin going through the IOS process while your church team prepares to go to Uganda, so that your time together is multiplied in its value and impact because each of you will know how the other operates and what the other “brings to the table”.

IP desires to serve your mission team to Uganda by giving them a picture of their unique gifts and how these gifts would work together as a God-ordained team on their trips. Our desire at Isaac's Promise is that church teams see their gifts in action as they minister together in the field, witness the gifts of the team interacting, and get a picture of the church participating in the Gospel together. As they minister together the church remembers the hope, inheritance, and power they have in Christ as they see the Body of Christ built up before their eyes; they put into play their unique gifts and watch results in every sphere of life. Then they return to the U.S. equipped to serve as a strategic team to your church by energizing the church body and bringing an understanding of their gifts working together to your church and its community.

How We Begin

Whether or not you personally will be able to come to Uganda this December, please go ahead and take a few minutes to complete The IOS Achievement Worksheet (attached as pages 6 and 7 of the IOS packet) and forward the completed worksheets to Jason Mitchell at isaacspromise@gmail.com . As you begin the process yourself, please forward the IOS Achievement Worksheet to each team member from your church who plans to go to Uganda this December for their completion. We are deeply indebted to each of you for your faithful ministry to the Body of Christ. You are a blessing and an encouragement to us, and we are eager to continue with you in the Gospel as we work together as a Body both in Uganda and the U.S.

In closing, this letter goes to the four of you, but we would like for you to be our eyes and ears and pass this out to any pastor, church, or individual who is desirous/eager to participate in a mission such as this.
