- 5. The fee is \$2,300, plus round-trip airfare to Entebbe, Uganda. Our agent provides discounted fares on quality airlines, and excellent service. Immunizations, visas, and outfitting are extra. Dates may vary slightly due to airline schedules.
- 6. You can become a liaison for your church to get involved. Team members' lives have been changed—Ellen Fox is an example.
