Event: Government of Uganda Imposes Lockdown

President Museveni announced a number of new measures to combat the spread of COVID-19, including a ban on the use of all private vehicles starting at 22:00 on March 30. This may have significant impact on the ability of U.S. citizens to book the Qatar Airways flight scheduled for Friday and to travel to Entebbe to catch the flight. The U.S. Embassy is seeking further guidance from the Government of Uganda and will communicate any possible solutions that are agreed upon regarding the issue of transporting yourself/family to the airport. Please do not send an email with questions pertaining to this at this time. We will send updated information as soon as we have it.

There are 33 confirmed cases of COVID-19 reported in Uganda.
