**Subject:** Uganda Follow-up on Ministry of George Yawe

In December of last year, I emailed info on a plan to help Pastor George Yawe's ministry in his native village of Kyamagemule. In 2007 George felt the leading of the Lord to start a ministry in Kyamagemule. This is a very rural village with no electricity, no medicinal clinic, no safe water, no school, not much of anything.

With his own money and on his families land, he built a church building which I first visited in 2008. In December of that year, a couple in the church I was pastoring gave me some funds to help in a village. With those funds, the very first building for a school was built. Just walls and a roof. No doors, no windows, and a dirt floor.

In 2010, with the help of another ministry, a deep well was drilled, providing clean water. Just three weeks ago I was there and saw a steady stream of villagers filling Jerry cans for their daily water needs.

Last year it became clear to me that we needed a big push to move things forward as the school had grown so that more students were in classes outside than in. There followed the December 2013 appeal for help and by God's grace and your generosity, great progress has been made. Construction continues now with the remain funds received this year. However, to finish what is underway and continue to make progress, I am renewing the appeal for construction funds for 2015. My goal is to provide the infrastructure that will allow the school to operate on its own. Below are some photos of the progress.
