Nalongo Lydia not in picture says. We had some family problems during that time and my husband wanted me to leave his house because he was seeing another woman. He denied the pregnancy I was carrying and he wanted me out of his way to be able to bring the other woman in the house. Life became very hard for me because I had no job and to make matters worse. I met my friend who brought me to the Comforter's Center. I came to the center knowing that it was a clinic and I wanted to abort my baby. The moment I entered I was introduced to a counselor and as she started talking to me, I revealed to her that I had come to carry out an abortion because of the difficulties I was facing. She started counseling me and told me that for them they do not carry out abortions but instead their work is to protect the unborn babies. I left the office and went back home when I was confused because what the counselor told me was different from what had brought me to the center. The counselor told me to come back such that we can talk more. When I started thinking about all that the counselor told me, I found out that it was true, being patience to carrying my pregnancy was the right thing for me to do at that time. When my friends heard that I have decided to carry the pregnancy they mocked me as a fool who do not real understand what I was facing and about the future. The day before I delivered my babies, I went for check up to see how my pregnancy was progressing. Unfortunately, when I reached the hospital, the nurse told me that she could not find the head of the baby and advised me to go for scanning the following day. I left the hospital frustrated because I had no money for scanning. The Comforter's Center sent me 30,000 Uganda shillings to help me and prayed to God to protect me and my baby. I didn't know that I was carrying twins. The twins came with changes in my life. The day I gave birth I received very many visitors most especially Christians from the church I was attending who brought me a lot of things including baby clothes and baby sheets. My husband came and took me home. He no longer treats me the way he used. My twins are now 2 months old and joy feels me whenever I look at them. My husband now a salongo (Uganda name for the father of twins) is a proud salongo in the community. I was almost going to loose my twins. and my new name Nalongo (twin Mother) I thank the staff and counselors of comforter's center for the great work they did to save the lives of my babies. The counseling I received from them, I was able to develop courage and strength to choose life for my babies. I give glory and honor to God
