Uganda Team Update February 1, 2010

This will be only a partial update as our team in Uganda has gone in three directions most of the time since being here. It is hoped this pictures and brief description will give some understanding of what part of the team has been doing.



This was the first day of our medical clinic. Here you can see Brandy Riggins, Assisting Dave Dietrich and he consults with an old man through the aid of an interpreter. Dave said by the end of the clinic the interpreter had learned the basic of medical diagnostics. Becky Carreira is seen in the back ground. She was the medical organizer and team pharmacists. Also with her is George Yewa, the pastor here in Kymagamule. This clinic ran for three days in two separate locations.



We had two Ugandan doctors and two Ugandan dentists join in the clinics. It seems there is a real desire for some medical

professionals in Kampala to join mission teams in providing village health care in remote areas. This is one of the dentists treating a young girl. I should add Panama City dentist Harry Futrell provided some dental tools and medical dental supplies used by the team. The lady dentist in this picture grew up in First Presbyterian Kampala and now teaches dentistry at Mulago University Hospital in Kampala.
