I continue to play catchup with the updates and will with this update focus on Monday, March 2

Sunday evening we traveled from Nyanzi to Kyamagemule where the heart of this work is located. Pastor George Yawe has created to guest rooms which share a toilet and shower so it is comfortable for us.

About 40 students are boarding students at the school with a total enrollment of over 300. In an additional update I will say more about the school and the new buildings they have.

Monday began the filter project for Michael while I spent time at the school, especially focusing on sponsorship students. We took over several <u>sponsorships</u> that Mercy Uganda had established and have now added seven more to the list. I am attempting to gather all the data I can on these children so our sponsors have a better understand of whom they are helping.
