Subject: Uganda Update for Sunday, June 19

I am way behind in my updates. I did not take my computer to the village but did take a lot of photos. I will produce a village eye clinic update later today or tomorrow.

I returned to our Entebbe Road Guest House on [Saturday](#) night in order to preach at a church in the area for Sunday services. The rest of the eye team stayed and worshiped in Kyamagemule and then returned to the guest house Sunday evening.

I got to preach at a church plant that has been meeting for about two years. It is in the Kajjansi area and is pastored by Westminster Bible College graduate Ben Tumugabe. The church met in his home for over a year. They now have a very nice facility to worship in pending the construction of a permanent building. When we drove up and I saw a big metal box (temporary facility) I was afraid it would be an oven. Instead it was very pleasant and I enjoyed teaching Sunday School and preaching. There was a good crowd and I wondered how such a group met in the pastor's house.

Ben told me the windows and roof in the temporary building will be used in the permanent facility. Good foresight that will save funds down the road.

It rained hard on Saturday and roads were a mess. On the way to the church it seems we might get stuck and have to walk in, but Ben did a good job of driving in the mud.
