Today we ended the week long teaching seminar at Lookout Ridge, the ACTI Guest House on Entebbe Road between Entebbe town and Kampala.

We had 17 men take part in the seminar and I think it went very well, at lest from the perspective of questions asked.

Many of you will remember the ambitious teaching schedule I sent out in January. Very ambitious but not realistic. I had set up about twenty-six session with twenty-five topics. We had the twenty-six sessions but only covered eight of the topics. Originally we were only going to include participants who were fluent in English. Three men came who needed translation so that changed the time element significantly.

They have already asked me to come back later this year.

Uganda continues to get very good rains and that is helping relieve some of the suffering and planting crops in the wet soil is in full force. However, the cost of food right now remains high as supply is and will remain short for a few more months. Please continue to remember the folks in your prayers.
