Subject: February 2018 Uganda Update
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After the long day of ministry on Friday, we left again early Saturday to the church plant at Kiroba. Kiroba is located between Jinja and Kimuli but much closer to Klmuli. We spent the nights at a guest hotel in Kimuli.

I am not certain how this location was selected, but the Hixson Presbyterian Church of Hixson, Tennessee has been sponsoring it from the start. We had well over 100 present Sunday I was part of the original open air campaign and house to house visitation a couple of years ago. On Sunday, the one part of the structure that has a roof was full with some folks standing outside looking through the windows.

In addition to Sunday School and worship, we did house to house visitation of church members and evangelism with some prospects. Saturday and Sunday afternoon, plus to 1:00 p.m. on Monday.

The Ugandan's respond so differently to visitors than Americans do. Not only do they treat you like most important guest they have ever had, the get their neighbors to come over too.

In the following photographs is a family from a non Christian background. He is 81 years old and had cataract surgery from Dr. Bonner last September. Since then, he and his family have been on the front row of the church every Sunday. He said what he had always been taught about Christians simply was not true.

One of the sad things we found when we visited his house was a child who is four years old who is smaller than a one year old also present. The mother had to continually restrain the one year old and the four year could not move much without help. We are working to get the child to a doctor in Jinja. The mother said the child had never been seen by a doctor.

Also in the photos below is the church building. It is in the shape of a T with only one wing of the T being covered. We filled that section. Also is a photo of some of the church member who had lunch outside following the service.
