After 19 months, it seems the door is once again opening for me to return to Uganda. This is the longest period I have been away since 2001. But by God's grace and in His will, I am planning to return on May 13. Dr. Henry Krabbendam and I are traveling together as it has been 16 months since he was there.

International travel is once again opening up and I have had two covid-19 immunization. In order to fly, I must have a negative test before departure and then another in Uganda before returning. With Jessica living here and Dabney planning to be here part of the time I am gone, we are confident Betsy will do well.

- Dr. K will return to Kampala for a conference there and I plan to travel to Kyamagemule for three days of ministry with my very good friend George William Yawe
- Then I will go to Seeta Nazigo where I have worked with Pastor Moses Odokaje many years
- Our travel plans are then for us to return on May 26

- That we will have no travel issues, going or coming back
- That our first conference with over 500 attending will go well
- That the three smaller conferences when we separate, will also be well attended and blessed
- That Betsy will have no issues while I am gone and continue to do well
