Tuesday, May 18 Uganda Update. First off, somehow I get the wrong location for out conference, we are not in Bushenyi, but nearby in Ntugamo, in the South Ankole Diocese of the Church of Uganda. The Bishop is Nathan Ahimbisibwe and is pictured below with Dr. Krabbendam. The cathedral is a beautiful building and is a great venue for this youth conference. Just understand, that in Uganda, you can be part of the youth right up to age 30.

Our program has been to challenge and train these young people in the ministry of evangelism. I believe that Dr. Krabbendam is correct when he says one of the reasons the United States is in the condition that it is, results from a failure of the American church to do the work of evangelism. It is very interesting to see an 85 year old American college professor get nearly 600 Ugandan youth on their feet while singing and dancing. The conference is advertised as a "Scientific Conference." We were told the science part is awareness of the spread of covid-19, masks and social distancing which satisfies the government for such a large event to take place.
