Subject: Uganda Christmas Baskets

Again this Christmas, we are working to provide food baskets to impoverished families, in the Ugandan villages where our teams work. We plan to transfer funds to local village pastors on Monday, December 20 so they may coordinate food basket distributions by Christmas Eve. Due to inflation's impact on the dollar, baskets this year will be \$30 each.

Each basket includes:

- 1 chicken (live)
- 1 kilogram of rice
- 1 kilogram of maize (corn) flour
- ½ kilogram of potatoes
- 1 liter of cooking oil
- 1 kilograms of sugar
- 1 loaf of bread
- 1 tub of Blue Band (margarine)
- 1 two liter soda
- All in a plastic dish pan that will be useful for months to come
- Some items available in specific villages will also be included

These baskets not only make it possible for these families to enjoy a special meal for Christmas, but some items will bless them for several days. Please make sure to clearly indicate your contribution "**Christmas Baskets**."
