- On Monday, we will travel to Seeta Nazigo for three days of ministry as above
- The on Thursday we ill travel to Kiroba and repeat the same ministry and then return to the guest house. Fred will fly out Monday night and I will leave Wednesday night.

We are grateful to so many of you who have made this trip possible, we have lots of children's clothes and other items to help poor rural families.

Also, I want to thank those of you who save aluminum cans that we recycle and convert into funds to help orphans. It is not uncommon for Betsy and me to drive up to our house and find a garbage back of cans sitting inside the fence. If you are throwing away and electrical items, after you unplug it, cut the cord off as that is copper and it recycles as well.
