We spent our first full day here in Kiroba and the response has been overwhelming. Dr. Rotich saw 99 patients today and we already have that many more registered for tomorrow. It is a very good thing that we brought Moses Odokaje with us from Seeta Nazigo. Before he studied at Westminster Bible Institute, he was a graduate nurse so he has help Dr. Rotich by dispensing all the medication which we are now purchasing more of for the fourth time this trip.

As in the past, we first share the gospel with all who show up and this included the kids from the school that the church began several years ago. It is always wonderful when some we share with come to us and ask to call out to Jesus for salvation.

We were able to complete another rainwater project this afternoon for two elderly ladies. As we were driving away from their home, it began to rain a little but the promise is for much rain tonight. Our final rainwater project is scheduled for tomorrow.
