Subject: Annual Christmas food appeal for Uganda

I hope this email finds you preparing for a great Christmas season. Life is often difficult in Uganda and is made even more complicated with the present Ebola situation. Right now we seek to serve our Ugandan friends practically in three specific ways. First we will offer the traditional food basket as we have done in the past. The second approach is to provide various animals that will help provide long lasting help. The third is bulk food for use by the schools to feed the children during the school year.

The **first** is the traditional funds with which we use buy food baskets for families. Roughly \$30 will provide food for a family for a month. Anyone is welcome to give any amount and all funds will be combined to meet as many needs as possible.

The **second** approach is to provide animals (goats, ducks, and chickens, etc) which we will distribute to families to help provide ongoing food relief. Goats provide milk, cheese and even meat, ducks provide eggs and meat, chickens eggs and meat as well. Any amount given for animals will be combined with other contributions to do as much as we can.

The **third** is bulk quantities of food for use by the school's meal program. As stated above, any amount received will be combined to do as much good as we can.
